Volunteering role for Trinity Methodist Church

Position title: Church steward

Main responsibilities:

- To facilitate and oversee all aspects of worship activities at the church, including ensuring
 visiting and regular preachers are welcomed and there are clear processes are in place for
 their role to be fulfilled
- To ensure children are brought into the church from Sunday Club, near the end of the service
- To deal with any unusual circumstances that might occur
- To attend Church Council and possibly Chelmsford Circuit meetings (noting that stewards become trustees of Trinity Church and some may be voted to be church representatives of the circuit)
- To undergo such training as, from time to time, is deemed appropriate for the effective, and/or statutorily necessary, fulfilment of the role
- To work towards taking on a lead role during their third year in post

Time allowed to fulfil the role:

- Stewards are on a rota and are responsible for approximately one service in every three, along with one other steward. They arrive well before the service is due to begin and, if necessary, unlock. They ensure that the premises are locked, if necessary, after the service. They could, thus, be on the premises for two hours or so.
- Stewards may be invited to do extra duties for "one off" events, such as funerals and weddings.
