Trigger warning: survivors of racism

On Tuesday 19 November 2024 from 11am – 12:30pm, the Methodist Church's Connexional Safeguarding Team will be offering a webinar on the subject of "Safeguarding and Racial Justice". All are welcome to attend.

In this webinar, we will explore how we can offer an inclusive welcome to people of all ethnicities within the Methodist Church and quickly tackle any issues relating to racism, whether overt or covert. We will hear too about the history of the Church's involvement with colonialism and slavery.

Speakers will also help us to learn more about our own unconscious biases and how we can challenge negative thoughts or comments in ourselves or others. By the end, we will consider how we can work together to make our church a safer and more welcoming place to people of all ethnicities.
